Letter from the President

Dear Colleagues:

I want to thank all of you for being patient with the blizzard of emails you have received regarding the new IHP participation agreement and Direct Contracting agreements. We have tried to limit them to the best of our ability, but there is just so much one can do. I know it has been confusing at times as we are doing two huge projects at the same time. I want to give you a couple of clarifications to hopefully clear up some common issues.

New IHP Participation Agreement

First, the IHP participation agreement is an update to the original agreement most of you signed in 2012. You must sign this new agreement to continue to be in the IHP network, participate in shared savings and be in-network for the INTEGRIS Health employee benefit plan, our MA plan, Aetna Whole Health and the United ACO. Many of you have expressed concern about IHP negotiating contracts as a group. Using IHP as a contracting vehicle ensures clinical integration and really is positive for all of us. Our ability to be rewarded for providing and demonstrating consistently high-quality care is stronger together than each of us on our own.

I will also alleviate your fears that this is a vehicle to move into mandatory participation in value-based MEDICAID contracts. It is NOT. We are not currently planning to pursue this strategy, but we will continue to assess the landscape in Oklahoma regarding all opportunities. Unlike Lincoln Riley, I promise IHP will be transparent regarding this issue, and you will have an opportunity to opt out of IHP participation if we should ever pursue that strategy.

Direct Contracting

Second, signing the Direct Contracting agreements is *not required* for IHP participation. These are two different things. I do encourage you to strongly consider participating in the Direct Contracting program. CMS has signaled value-based payment is the foundation of their plans for future payment requirements. As we have discussed, we are seeing increased acceleration of movement away from fee-for-service to value in commercial payers as well. There are real potential upsides to this program for the patient and physician. The risk is low at this point. It is best to learn how to do this now when there is little downside risk. I think in the next few years, this will not be the case, and those of us who have learned the ropes will fare better.

Getting these agreements and contracts signed has been a huge task and very worthwhile. We have also been able to update our rosters and contact information which will lead to better communication with IHP members and their supporting staff.

I have really enjoyed talking to many of you during this process. Your questions have been appropriate and enlightening. Please do not hesitate to contact me if you have any questions or concerns. I will be calling you if you decide to withdraw from IHP. This will help me understand what led to your decision and consider changing those things that are potentially problematic.

I hope all of you have a wonderful holiday season. Take care of yourself and spend time with those you love. We all need to be in a good place to deliver exceptional care to our patients.

INTEGRIS Health Partners Network Participation Agreement

On November 15, 2021, independent IHP providers received an email via DocuSign containing the new IHP network participation agreement. With the changes happening in the structure of IHP due to the development of a Population Health Services Organization (PHSO), entering Medicare Direct Contracting, starting our own MA plans, and beginning to be involved in other-risk-taking agreements, it is necessary to make adjustments to our network participation agreements. The document you received is the result of numerous discussions between IHP leadership, the IHP Board of Directors and the legal team. The agreement was unanimously approved by the IHP Board at a special meeting on October 25, 2021. The Board has fully vetted this agreement and has approved a resolution stating this will be our new participation agreement.

If you have not yet done so, please review and sign the full agreement that you received by December 6, 2021.

This agreement is needed to move forward on our plans for Direct Contracting, negotiating other value-based agreements and managing our MA plan.

This agreement will allow IHP to execute our strategy to be the leader in value-based care in Oklahoma and continue to deliver value and excellent care to our patients.

You must sign this new agreement to continue to be in the IHP network, participate in shared savings, and be in-network for the INTEGRIS employee health plan, our MA plan, Aetna Whole Health, and the United ACO.

Effective January 1, 2022, IHP will begin participation in the CMS Direct Contracting program for Medicare fee-for-service beneficiaries.

In early November, IHP caregivers received communication from Esse Health ACO DCE through DocuSign with the participating provider participation agreement, fee reduction agreement, and required forms for the new INTEGRIS Health Direct Contracting program.
