FIRE: All employees take appropriate action R.A.C.E. (Rescue, Alarm, Confine, Extinguish) P.A.S.S. (Pull, Aim, Squeeze, Sweep) for extinguisher use

Code Blue



CARDIAC/RESPIRATORY ARREST: Initiate CPR

All personnel refrain from using elevator

Code Black



SEVERE WEATHER: Phase 1 – Watch Issued, Heighten Awareness, Phase 2 – Warning – Move patients to safe location

Tornado – Move patients away from outside walls and windows
Floods- Highest elevated locations

External Disaster: Disaster has occurred in the community Disaster Plan activated

Prepare for influx of patients

Code Green



Disruptive Patient or Family Member

Calmly and quietly clear the area of non-essential persons Call 9 911 if needed

Code Pink



MISSING INFANT: Designated staff to secure exits Ask patient/visitor/staff not to leave Follow department plans

Code Silver



Bomb Threat - No Overhead Page Keep person on the line, Call 9 911

Code Adam



Missing Child: Designated staff to secure exits Ask patient/visitor/staff not to leave Follow department plans



Chemical Incident:

Call Environmental Services immediately to alert HazMat team

Code Zero



EarthQuake.

Duck and cover, protect head Triage, survey damage, take action
