2. Author(s) (One or more authors may be familiar. If the author's track record is good & of good reputation, read on. If the author is unfamiliar, consider the reputation of the journal.)
3. What is the research question?
4. What method(s) are used to answer the research question?  
(Retrospective? Prospective?)
5. Are the methods used able to answer the research question?
6. What variables are measured?
7. What are some confounding variables or other sources of error in the paper?
8. What were the major conclusions of the paper?
9. Do you believe the conclusions are valid and why?
10. Are the results of this paper generalizable to your practice?
11. Will you apply the results of this paper to your practice?
