

Code Yellow



External Disaster – Phase 1 & 2*:

- 1 - Disaster has occurred in the community.
- 2 - Disaster plan activated. Prepare for influx of patients.

ALL physicians

- Be aware Code Yellow means *external disaster*. Code will be paged overhead.

CODE YELLOW PHASE 1 = Disaster information received:

- Community incident occurred which may produce numerous emergency patients at the hospital in a short period of time.
- Physicians and staff should be aware, review internal resources, staffing availability and response protocols for an influx of patients. Plan not implemented until Phase 2 is called.

CODE YELLOW PHASE 2 = Disaster plan implemented due to expected influx of patients:

- Hospital Command Center activated. See [Staging Locations](#) below.
- Affiliated physicians volunteering to assist with patient care should first report to ED.
- **ED staff physician will coordinate physician responsibilities.**
- Non-affiliated physicians should report to Hospital Command Center for credentialing.
- Assist with patient care as needed if you are in the area or respond to the area.
- Departments will follow their protocols for influx of patients.
