- **Coach a Kid – Enid**

- The Coach-A-Kid Enid Mentor Program is a new and exciting volunteer mentoring program in Enid, Oklahoma. Coach-A-Kid Enid is aimed at enriching the student's educational experience. The Coach-A-Kid Enid program provides students with positive role models from the Enid area. *Mentors share 30-60 minutes per week* providing assistance for students in academic improvement, self-esteem building, behaviour skills, positive attitude development and emphasizing the importance of regular attendance. A successful mentoring program helps to produce, in the long term, stronger, more confident and well-prepared young people to enter our workforce and become productive citizens in our community. - **Mentor Guidelines:**
 - Coach-A-Kid Enid has established minimum guidelines for volunteers participating in the mentoring program. These guidelines and guidelines are to help ensure successful outcomes for all mentoring relationships. A Coach-A-Kid Enid mentor:
 - ✓ Commits to serving a minimum of one school year in the program.
 - ✓ Is in good standing with the established policies and procedures of the Coach-A-Kid Enid program and their employer.
 - ✓ Attends a Coach-A-Kid Enid Orientation.
 - ✓ Follows all established policies and procedures of Enid Public Schools and the operation of each school as identified by the school principal.
 - ✓ Participates in a one-on-one relationship with the child (30-60 minutes per week, during the school day) in the designated area at the school site, as assigned by the school.
 - ✓ Provides advanced notification to Coach-A-Kid Enid and the school when he/she is unable to attend.

- ✓ Acts under the direction of Coach-A-Kid Enid, the classroom teacher and/or school Principal or Counsellor.

- **Boys & Girls Club – Miami and Grove**

- For mentoring at the Boys and Girls Clubs, you will fill out a profile and be matched up by the Executive Director with one of the club kids. It will be a 1 hour per week commitment for 12 of 15 weeks.
